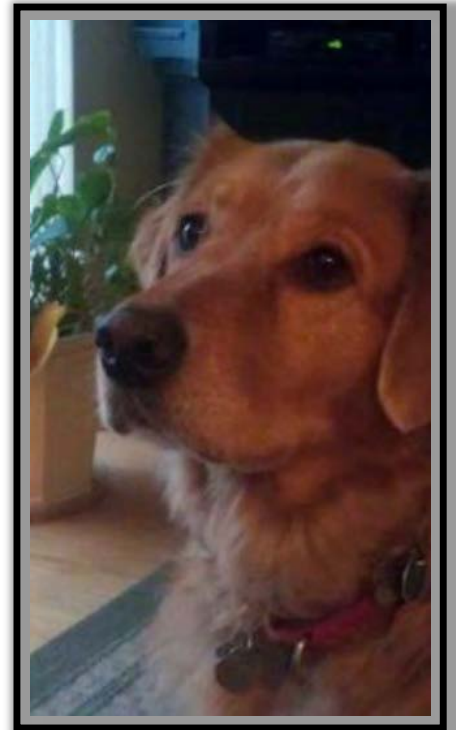
TAWNY (GH288)
